

**Word Study: Unit 10**  
**spelling – ou and ow**  
**vocabulary – a musical performance**

In word study this week, we will work on words that make the vowel sound in clown. Even though these words sound the same, they can be spelled one of two ways:

“ow” or “ou”

The only exception this week is the word “would.” Although “would” has the “ou” pattern, the vowels make the /oo/ sound in “cook.”
