| 1. <u>digit</u> : | one of the ten numerals, 0 through 9 |
| 2. <u>even</u> : | able to be divided by two |
| 3. <u>decimal</u> : | a number containing a period to separate whole numbers from fractions |
| 4. <u>fraction</u> : | a number, such as $\frac{3}{4}$, that compares a part with a whole |
| 5. <u>odd</u> : | not able to be divided by two |
